**Sale Birds - Can be entered up until 26<sup>th</sup> April. Preference of cages will be given to early entries. Then entries will be taken on the day with own display cages only**

Show benching from 8 am to 9.30 am. Sale Birds accepted from 10 am.

Payment for Sale Birds cannot be made until 1.30 pm on the sale day or by Bank transfer.

Show Class entry fee -\$3 per bird, plus Show membership \$5 per person/\$10 family.

No entry fee for Sale Birds. The Club gets 15% per bird sold. No charge for use of cages.

**A BBQ & Snacks will be available for sale**

We will have a Sale Bird area at the Young Bird Show and expect lots of interest in this. **Condition of Sales & Showing:** This is an open show, anybody who owns or breeds poultry or pigeons may enter under these conditions.

Only 8 birds per purchase to keep the flow of transactions for cashier. You may purchase as many times as you wish but 8 or under each time.

You abide by the Club Show & Sales rules. No other sales or deals are to be made within the confines of the Hall or car park, other than through the Club.

Showing of Birds & Sale is open to all according to the rules set down by the committee.

The Club does not accept responsibility for loss or damage to birds, equipment, or persons for the duration of the event. Care will be taken of birds while exhibited - Club members will feed & water the birds throughout the day.

All birds entered in the Showing section must be under 12 months of age at 1<sup>st</sup> March 2024 (prefer not under 12 weeks at time of entry)

All fees must be paid at time of entry.

Only one member of a family may show a breed. If members of a family are classed as Novice, they must be the owner or breeder of the birds.

Children must be over the age of 5 to enter the show in any section.

If you wish to be included in the watching & listening to judging, please let the committee know as space is limited.

**Classes, Open section,** anybody may enter this section but not both Novice & Open.

**Novice,** for the newcomer. If you have not had a bird of any breed or type Placed 1 or 2<sup>nd</sup> at an open show.

**Cross Breed Section.** Open to all exhibitors. For birds of unknown Breed or a cross of more than one breed.
