## **Conditions of Entry**

By placing your entries you agree to adhere to the rules and regulations of the Central Districts Poultry & Pigeon Club & the NZ (NI) Poultry Pigeon & Birds Assoc. Inc.

All entries must be accompanied by entrance money or they will be refused. No late entries will be accepted. If you have extra entries put these on a separate piece of paper. Duplicate entry forms are not required.

Birds must be presented in a good healthy condition and birds infested with lice or otherwise unhealthy will not be accepted. Any birds in doubtful condition will be removed from cages. No birds are to be removed from cages during the show except by the judges or steward of that section, or designated official.

When entering A.O.S.V & A.O.S.C Classes the breed or colour MUST be stated.

Judges are empowered not to award any prize or special prize to an exhibit, which they consider is not of sufficient merit. The Judge may award a second or third prize or may withhold all prizes.

By entering this show you are giving permission for your name etc to be published in relation to the privacy act. The show membership fee gives you and your family free access to the show and allows you to compete for all Central Districts ribbons, trophies, cash and North Island Championships.

Winners of cups and shields must apply to the Show Secretary if wishing to take them home for the year, in which case they are to be engraved at your own expense and returned before the first day of the next annual show.

**Please Note: No photos are to be taken of birds benched at a show until after the conclusion of all judging.**

## **Leg Rings and Leg Tags**

1. It is permissible for poultry to be shown with a leg ring that is issued by the North Island Association or an affiliated club appointed by the North Island Association.
2. Only white string or white/clear electrical ties are to be used when attaching leg tags issued by clubs.

## **Protest**

Any Protest made must be in writing (forms are available) with a fee of \$10.00. The fee is refundable if the protest is upheld.

The protest must be lodged with the Show Manager prior to 10am Sunday 14 May.
